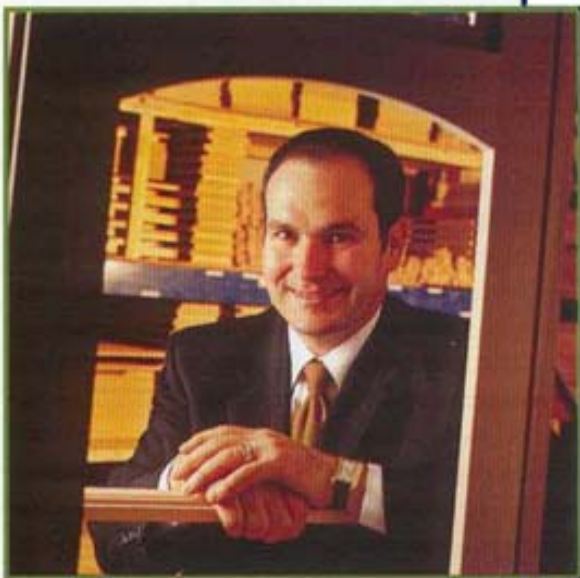
As strange as it sounds, a mail strike in Canada was one of the reasons Denis Malaket ended up pursuing his MBA in Miami. The Quebec native, having done his undergraduate work in Ottawa, had applied to several local universities as well as to UM, which he chose partly because his parents had a home here. Due to the mail strike, his acceptance letter from the School was the first to arrive, and off he went to registration, armed with a map of the area.

"I was considered a foreign student, which was a little weird," says Malaket. Now the senior vice president of administration for Shermag, Canada's leading furniture manufacturer, Malaket calls his graduate experience "two of the best years of my life. I think we had a great program there. Of course it's academic, but it's also about hands-on practical experience."

He initially worked as a controller in an oil refinery, then moved to his family's business, Malaket Furniture. "Working in a family business can never be too easy," Malaket observes. He moved on to Catelli, a food producer, where he became a budget director. His next job, at a management turnaround firm, led him to Shermag, which had been his account. Malaket and Shermag's president, Serge Racine, ended up becoming involved in an outside growth management business together. Meanwhile, Malaket's ongoing work for Shermag was so productive that he was persuaded to join the company full time as junior vice president. A year later, Malaket, who is married and has two sons, was promoted again.

In his present position, Malaket oversees customer service, information systems management, transport and credit. "I am in charge of inventory, I approve all the production going into the plants, I follow the division heads," he says.

"When I was at the School of Business," he adds, "I was a graduate assistant in the Management Department, working with [department chair] Dr. Linda Neider.
